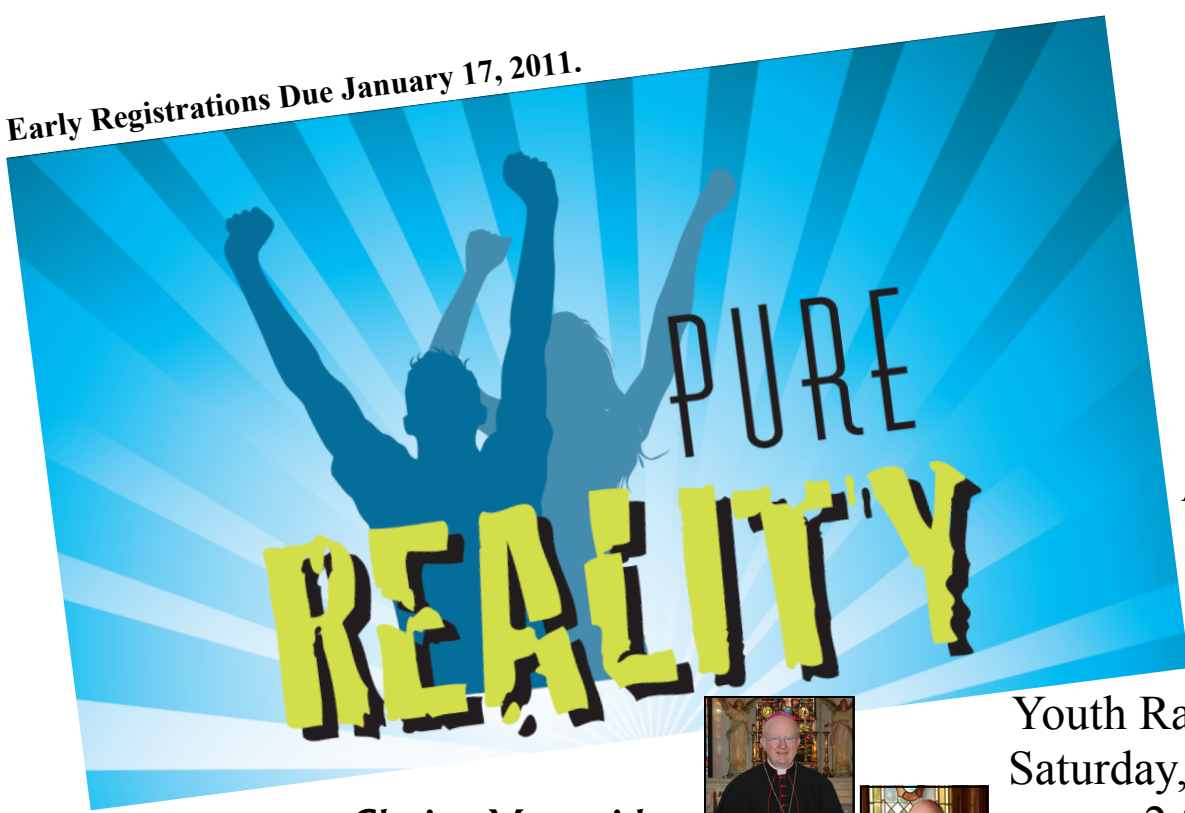

Large Group Youth Event Safe Environment Procedures Diocese of Fort Worth

Thank you for helping us to provide a safe environment for all young people at the Pure Reality Rally on Saturday, February 12, 2011, at the Metro Center in Arlington, Texas. There is a very specific process that we ask every group to use for large group events for young people under age 18 (any event with more than 100 people) held in the Diocese of Fort Worth to ensure safety.

1. Persons must register as a parish or school group. Young people will not be allowed to register and attend this event individually. Parents may bring their own children, but must still provide proof of Safe Environment Clearance.
2. You will need 1 adult for every 6 teens from each parish or school, with a minimum of 2 adults at all times. If parish/school has 1-12 teenagers, then they will need to have 2 adults; 12-18 teens, they will need 3 adults; and so forth.
3. All adult chaperones who are attending must have gone through the Fort Worth or Dallas diocesan-approved SAFE ENVIRONMENT TRAINING. No other safe environment programs are accepted as equivalent at this time including Scout or work-related training programs. Youth ministers are responsible for confirming clearance of their chaperones.
4. Each parish/school group will present to the registration desk a binder with a listing of all attendees in alphabetical order (they should use the Parish Release Form Data Tracking Sheet to create this listing) and then copies of the Pure Reality Youth or Adult Release Form for each attendee.
5. When your parish/school group arrives to check-in, you will turn in your binder to be checked. Once the binder has been checked and OK'd, the parish leader is given a signed Registration Voucher which they will take to the main registration desk where they will receive their group's name badges and packets, t-shirts, etc. We do allow parish/school groups to turn their binder in 10 days prior to the event which allows us to check them before the conference. These parishes are then allowed to go through SPEED CHECK-IN with no wait.
6. Each parish/school group will assign an ON-SITE KEY LEADER CONTACT. This is the person attending the rally who is in charge of your group. We need their name, position and cell phone number.

Thank you for following these procedures to ensure a safe environment for all young people attending large group youth events in the Diocese of Fort Worth.
